

2021 Turnstone Endeavor Games COVID Plan

This document is subject to change at any time, in accordance with the United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee Sports Event Planning Considerations and local, state, and federal COVID-19 guidelines.

Participant Types

- Tier 1: individuals who may have direct, close contact with athletes; this includes athletes, officials, coaches, classifiers, medical, and spectators (family).
- Tier 2: individuals who don't have direct, close contact with athletes; this includes volunteers, local sponsors and national partners, media, and event staff.

It is the responsibility of every event participant to protect their own health, as well as the health of others.

General Information

- Tier 1 and/or Tier 2 participants **cannot** attend or participate in the 2021 Turnstone Endeavor Games in-person if:
 - They have tested positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the start of competition.
 - They still have a fever or it has been less than 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever reducing medicine.
 - They have other persisting symptoms common to COVID-19 (difficulty breathing, cough, body aches, etc.).
 - They have new symptoms common to COVID-19 (difficulty breathing, cough, fever greater than 100.4 F, loss of taste/smell, etc.).
 - They have been exposed to someone with known or suspected COVID-19 infection within 14 days of the start of competition.
- While at the 2021 Turnstone Endeavor Games in-person, Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Conduct a daily self-assessment for symptoms common to COVID-19:
 - Any new cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing in the last 48 hours?
 - Fever of 100.4 F or higher in the last 48 hours?
 - Chills, body aches, runny nose, congestion, sore throat, head ache in the last 48 hours?
 - New loss of taste or smell in the last 48 hours?
 - New gastrointestinal symptoms in the last 48 hours?
- Any participant who develops symptoms common to COVID-19 while at the 2021 Turnstone Endeavor Games in-person will:
 - Report those symptoms to event staff.
 - Quarantine themselves from the event and other participants by leaving the premises
 - No longer be permitted to participate in the Games in-person.
- Reminders for Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants:
 - Masks must be worn properly indoors—fully covering the nose and mouth.
 - Physical distancing of 6 feet or more is required between yourself and others who are not within your same household.

- Avoid touching the hands of others (handshakes, high fives, etc.).
- Don't share personal items with others.
- Hand washing and sanitization should be done frequently. Sanitizers will be accessible and available at all venues.
- If you feel more comfortable wearing gloves, be sure they are non-latex.

- If an athlete needs help from an Athletic Trainer, please wear a mask. Hand sanitizer will be available to use.

Venue Specific Guidelines

- Turnstone Center
 - Face masks are required to be worn at all times inside the building.
 - Maintain physical distancing by allowing at least 6 feet between yourself and others—including in the stands/seating areas.
 - Frequent hand washing and sanitization is encouraged.
- The X Count
 - Face masks are recommended.
 - Maintain physical distancing by allowing at least 6 feet between yourself and others—including in the stands/seating areas.
 - Facilities will undergo increased sanitization measures.
 - Frequent hand washing and sanitization is encouraged.
- Indiana Tech Warrior Park
 - Face masks are recommended.
 - Maintain physical distancing by allowing at least 6 feet between yourself and others—including in the stands/seating areas.
 - Frequent hand washing and sanitization is encouraged.
- Carroll High School
 - Face masks are required to be worn at all times inside the building.
 - Maintain physical distancing by allowing at least 6 feet between yourself and others—including in the stands/seating areas.
 - Frequent hand washing and sanitization is encouraged.

Sport Specific Guidelines

- Air Rifle Shooting
 - Clinic and competition
 - Shared equipment will be sanitized for each new shooter.
 - All equipment and surrounding area will be sanitized between each clinic and competition.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.

- All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.
- Archery
 - Clinic and competition
 - Outdoor- no shared equipment unless absolutely necessary, in which case equipment will be sanitized between each new shooter.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.
 - Masks are recommended.
 - All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.
- Goalball
 - Clinic/ Competition
 - Shared equipment will be sanitized for each new athlete.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.
- Boccia
 - Clinic/ Competition
 - Shared equipment will be sanitized for each new athlete.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.

- Sitting Volleyball
 - Clinic and competition
 - All equipment and surrounding area will be sanitized between each clinic and each game.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.
- Swimming
 - Clinic and competition
 - Shared equipment will be sanitized for each new athlete.
 - All equipment and surrounding area will be sanitized between each clinic and competition.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly when not actively in the pool:
 - Disposable masks will be issued in athlete packet
 - Disposable masks will be worn to the starting block
 - Athletes will dispose of masks prior to race
 - Athletes will dry face and collect new disposable masks at the finish line
 - Athletes will wear new disposable masks while at the competition site, or until next race
 - All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.
 - Venue specific guidelines for Mitch Park are to be followed.
- Wheelchair Tennis
 - Shared equipment will be sanitized for each new athlete.
 - All equipment and surrounding area will be sanitized between each competition.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.

- All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.
- Track and Field
 - Clinic and competition
 - Shared equipment will be sanitized for each new athlete.
 - All equipment and surrounding area will be sanitized between each clinic and competition.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.
 - Mask are recommended.
 - All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.
- Wheelchair Basketball
 - Shared equipment will be sanitized for each new athlete.
 - All equipment and surrounding area will be sanitized between each clinic and each game.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.
- Power Soccer
 - Shared equipment will be sanitized for each new athlete.
 - All equipment and surrounding area will be sanitized between each clinic and each game.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.

- Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.

- Wheelchair Softball
 - Shared equipment will be sanitized for each new athlete.
 - All equipment and surrounding area will be sanitized between each competition.
 - Athletes will:
 - Sanitize their hands before and after using equipment.
 - Be physically distanced from each other as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic
 - All other Tier 1 and Tier 2 participants will:
 - Be physically distanced from each other and athletes as much as possible.
 - Wear their masks properly for the duration of the clinic/competition.
 - Frequently wash and sanitize their hands.

Transportation Information

- Participants and/or families within the same household are encouraged to drive to the 2021 Turnstone Endeavor Games if possible.
- Venue to venue transportation will be offered in an adjusted format:
 - Vans will be limited to one participant (and others within their same household, as applicable) at a time.
 - Masks are mandatory
 - Participants and/or families within the same household are encouraged to drive their own vehicles venue to venue at the 2021 Turnstone Endeavor Games if possible.

Special Event Information

- Welcome Party:
 - Will be indoors
 - Tables and chairs will be sanitized before and after the event
 - Masks are to be worn properly for the duration of the event, except when actively eating or drinking
 - Physical distancing is required, especially when eating and/or drinking
 - Frequent washing and sanitization of hands is encouraged
